Outlook and goals

The objective of EMMAG is to favor university exchanges thanks to academic mobilities for a best international cooperation in higher education and scientific research. More specifically, EMMAG aspires to:

- Better reinforce the cooperation between universities of Mediterranean Partner Countries and European universities
- Contribute to improve the employability of young graduates of third country institutions to increase economic growth
- Exchange experiences for a better efficiency in the implementation of international mobility programmes

The partnership will manage mobility flows between Europe and MPC for a range of academic levels – undergraduate, masters, doctorate, post-doctorate – and for academic and administrative staff. The participants will receive mobility grants for the length of their stay. The return travel and health insurance are covered by the EMMAG program.
