Philosophy and objectives

The TEMPUS project "Accompanying measures in the design, management and monitoring of international cooperation projects: MonProG" is a project of the National Structural Measures funded by the European Union for a term of three years.

It responds to the national priority "Development of International Relations." The overall objective is to improve the international image of Moroccan universities by increasing their participation in international projects and developing their installation and management capacity of these projects via the transfer of know-how from European partners to Mediterranean partners.

For this purpose, are planned training of trainers for installation and management of European and international projects organized in Morocco in the partner universities. Each Moroccan partner will then have the task of organizing information and training sessions within their own home institution that will have feedback value.

Reference documents presenting good practices and recommendations will be developed at the end of the program. Based on a "Quality" approach, this project should lead to the establishment within Moroccan universities of cooperation services welcoming qualified staff.

Tempus IV, le project MonProG today: dates and figures

This project is funded by the European Union for a period of 3 years (December 2013-November 2016) and a budget of 860.232,71 €. The launch meeting was held in Fez, Morocco in March 2014.

Tethys welcomed 20 Moroccan participants on June 2014 in a professional observation two-day session with presentations from Tethys, AMU, the AMU Cell Europe, Protisvalor, SATT. For the opening were represented Aix-Marseille University, the Representation of the European Commission in Marseille, the City of Marseille.

8 trainings of trainers' sessions take place from September 2014 up to a month until April 2015. Tethys (Aix-Marseille University) conducted the training in Beni Mellal in January 2015 (the Erasmus + Program: presentation and practical cases) and in Kenitra in February 2015 (the H2020 Program: presentation and case studies).
